What do you notice about this insect? What do you wonder about this insect? What does it remind you of?

There are three types of Swallowtails that visit the garden – Giant, Anise, and Tiger, the latter being the most common and spectacular. Sycamore leaves are the host plant of their larvae. If mud forms near the water feature, several will gather to *puddle*, flapping their wings while sipping minerals from the mud.
