Try This Easy-to-Grow California Native: Bladderpod



ORANGE-CROWNED WARBLER

Favorite food: Nectar, Insects, Some Berries

Favorite garden plant: Bladderpod, Peritoma arborea

What do you notice about this bird? What do you wonder about this bird? What does it remind you of?

This common little olive-green warbler is always on the go! You'll hear its constant 'Chip!' while consuming insects from trees, and nectar from Bladderpods. The male's orange *crown* is rarely seen unless he's angrily defending a nest or territory. Then, bright feathers a top his head stand straight up like the fur on an angry cat.
