Look for it with all its buddies up in the Sycamore trees. Their voices are a high-pitched “PEEP PEEP PEEP!” These beautiful birds have a prominent **crest** on their head, a black eye mask, and a tail that looks like the tip was dipped in yellow paint. Flocks of up to 72 individuals return to the garden each year.
